With this filing, NBTC is proposing revisions to its Pricing Flexibility tariff section to reflect changes resulting from NBTC's 2006 Annual Access Filing, effective July 1, 2006. New services were incorporated into a basket or service for which Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief had been granted in multiple qualifying areas, resulting in WaveMANSM receiving the same pricing flexibility in the same multiple qualifying areas. Revisions include adding WaveMANSM to the Price Flex Section, and adding verbiage to inform customers, who purchase a Pricing Plan pursuant to Section 16, that they will be subject to the Price Flex rates in Section 22.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
