This application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to the following AT&T Companies: Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, and The Southern New England Telephone Company (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39.

NBTC proposes to introduce Contract offer No. YY - Wireless Advantage Managed Services Value Incentive Plan (WAMS-VIP) Offer, a special access discount pricing plan that is structured to include the AT&T Telephone Companies, as listed above, for Customers located in Phase I and/or Phase II Pricing Flexibility Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs), as described in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 22. This waiver request is being submitted due to the Eligibility Criteria which requires Customers to concurrently subscribe to the identical contract offers pursuant to the following tariffs: SNET Tariff F.C.C. No. 39, Section 25, Contract Offer No. YY; Ameritech Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Section 22, Contract Offer No. YY; SWBT Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, Section 41, Contract Offer No. YY; and PBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 33, Contract Offer No. YY. Concurrent subscription provides Customers with the opportunity to achieve the Baseline Minimum Annual Revenue Commitment (Baseline MARC) with revenue in any combination of the AT&T Telephone Companies' tariffs and receive incentives and discounts on qualified access services, as listed in Section 23.YY.2.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to include the above mentioned tariff references in its proposed contract tariff filing. Applications to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules are also being requested by Ameritech, SWBT, PBTC, and SNET for the WAMS-VIP Offer in separate applications.
