In Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking¹, the FCC concluded that Verizon was no longer required to offer Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) Service as a telecommunications service under Title II of the Communications Act. With this filing, Verizon is removing its DSL services from Tariff FCC Nos. 1 and 20 in order to offer them under contract.
