Under authority of Special Permission No. 06-036 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce a new Contract Tariff Option (New Option) in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11. The New Option is an offering exclusively for customers who commit to convert their 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Unbundled Network Elements (Eligible UNEs) that were previously purchased from Verizon to DS1 and DS3 Special Access Services purchased under Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11.

When the requirements set forth in the attached tariff pages are met, the customer will receive discounted monthly recurring rates for their DS1 and DS3 Special Access Services that are subscribed to under this New Option. This New Option also provides certain benefits to the circuit-specific or commitment term plan associated with the DS1 and DS3 Special Access Services that are subscribed to under this New Option. An Early Commitment Signing Bonus Credit is also available to customers who subscribe to the New Option on or before November 19, 2006, and meet certain criteria for such bonus as set forth in the attached tariff pages.

The New Option is filed pursuant to Verizon receiving Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying MSAs.

Supporting material under Section 61.49 is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
