**PURPOSE**

With this filing, Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) is proposing to add clarifying language to the Expedite Charges Section of the tariff explaining the applicable charges processed when an expedited service date is missed due to the customer not being ready for service.

**DESCRIPTION**

Expedites are initiated by the customer, via an ASR, when they want service installed sooner than the standard interval. Today, if an expedited service date is missed due to the customer not being ready for service, we assess an Expedite Order Charge or Expedite Circuit Charge. We may also assess Service Date Change Charge and a Dispatch Charge, if applicable. Additionally, if the customer subsequently requests expedited service for the same circuit or order (prior to service installation), an Additional Expedited Order Charge or Additional Expedited Circuit Charge is applied. We are clarifying the language in the tariff to support our current processes. There will be no impact on how customers are currently being billed.
