Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal 145 without its becoming effective.

On November 2, 2006, NBTC proposed various modifications to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. The modifications add clarifying language to the Expedite Charges Section of the tariff to explain the applicable charges processed when an expedited service date is missed due to the customer not being ready for service. Transmittal 145 is scheduled to become effective on November 17, 2006.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw the tariff material filed under Transmittal 145, without its becoming effective. NBTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal 145 in order to review issues identified in the proposed modifications. The illustrative tariff page is attached.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective November 17, 2006, on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that is not yet in effect.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff page are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
