With this filing, Verizon is removing Internet Protocol (IP) Port from Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14, and 20 in accordance with the relief received in connection with its Forbearance Petition in WC Docket No. 04-440. Additionally, Verizon is detariffing in its entirety a specialized service arrangement for IP Port and related interconnection provided under Tariff FCC No. 14.

IP Port is being removed from price caps (applicable to FCC No. 1 only). There is no base period demand for these services, and the price cap indices are not changed as a result of this filing. See Workpaper New Jersey IP Port Removal Detail and Workpaper Indices Comparison. Support material as specified in Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is attached.
