The accompanying tariff material, issued by Nevada Bell Telephone Companies (NBTC) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

With this filing, NBTC is proposing to introduce rate reductions in areas where the F.C.C. has granted Phase II pricing flexibility for price cap services, which is being filed in compliance with Special Access Merger Commitment # 6 of the AT&T/BellSouth merger. Channel termination, fixed and per-mile rates for interstate DS1 and DS3 services, and Ethernet services, will be offered at rates no higher than, and on the same terms and conditions as, price cap rates for these services. This provision is temporary, and will remain in effect until June 30, 2010.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
