With this transmittal, Verizon is introducing DS3 Transmux Ports which is available as a new option for customers who purchase Verizon Dedicated SONET Ring (DSR) service. The DS3 Transmux ports are provided on Enhanced OC3 nodes for both Switched Access and Special Access DSR service arrangements.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the F.C.C.'s Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto. In addition, Figure 1, provided as an attachment to this filing, will be used in the 2007 Annual Filing to demonstrate that the new rate elements being introduced in Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11 should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and the non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.
