RE: May 1st Shortform TRP Letter Filing

The Verizon Telephone Companies¹ will be filing their 2007 Annual Price Cap Filing in compliance with Section 61.43 of the Commission's rules. As required by Section 61.49(k), attached is an advance submission of Verizon's 2007 Tariff Review Plan (TRP) for the purpose of early review. The submission is in the format prescribed in the 2007 Tariff Review Plan Order.²

This filing provides the necessary inputs and documentation to calculate the new Price Cap Indices. The new Price Cap Indices reflect the use of 2006 base period demand and changes in exogenous costs. All support documentation is provided as an attachment with this Letter.
