

**NEVADA BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY
DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION
May 18, 2007
TRANSMITTAL NO. 155**

PURPOSE

With this filing, Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) proposes to clarify rate regulations and effective dates for rate reductions from Transmittal No. 152 that became effective on April 5, 2007. These rate reductions were made in compliance with Special Access Merger Commitment # 6 of F.C.C. Docket No. 06-74, for the AT&T/BellSouth merger.

DESCRIPTION

NBTC proposes language to clarify that temporarily reduced rates for DS1 and DS3 channel termination and/or mileage services, filed on Transmittal No. 152, apply solely to interstate services, and that these reduced rates expire on June 30, 2010. In addition, new rate pages are being introduced for DS1 and DS3 channel termination and mileage services that reflect rates that were in effect on April 4, 2007, and that will be effective again on July 1, 2010.

PRICE CAP COMPLIANCE

Pursuant to Part 69.727(b) of the Commission's Rules, no supporting documentation is required for Phase II pricing flexibility filings.
