10.9.5 Washington Interagency Telecommunications System 2001

(A) General

Washington Interagency Telecommunications System 2001 (WITS 2001) is a uniquely rated and designed data telecommunications switching and transport service arrangement for the General Services Administration (GSA). WITS 2001 provides specific Special Access and Packet Data services (i.e., Dedicated Transmission Services DTS), Frame Relay Service (FRS), Asynchronous Transfer Mode - Cell Relay (ATM), Switched Multi-megabit Data Service* (SMDS) and Tariffed Service Components. WITS 2001 is designed for the exclusive use of GSA, various federal agencies, and other designated end users, and provides transmission services between and among them and their designated interexchange carriers and/or information service providers.

(B) Terms and Conditions

WITS 2001 is provided pursuant to an eight-year contract arrangement (a four-year base period and four one-year options), commencing with the tariff effective date (a.k.a., anniversary or contract date). This tariff states first year rates and will be amended to state rates for succeeding years on or before expiration of the first anniversary date. Except as otherwise stated in this section, the services provided are the same as those services described in Sections 7, 8 and 16 of this tariff. The services are subject to the general regulations of this tariff unless otherwise stated.

* Effective January 1, 2002, this service will no longer be available to new Customers. New subscriber network interfaces for existing SMDS customers will not be available effective January 1, 2002. Existing SMDS Customers are also limited to current in-place facilities effective January 1, 2002. Transfers to new service locations or upgrades to existing subscriber network interface access connections will not be available effective January 1, 2002.

(2) Tariffed Service Components

The Tariffed Service Components offered in this Section 10.9.5(C)(2) can only be used to connect to Telephone Company provided dedicated SONET ring service.

(a) Ports

Ports allow lower level signals to be transported over Telephone Company provided dedicated SONET ring service. Ports must be ordered in symmetrical (e.g., DS3 Port to DS3 Port) arrangements.

Signals will be mapped as follows:

- DS1 mapped as VT1.5
- DS3 mapped as STS1
- STS1 mapped as STS1

Except as otherwise stated in this section, the Ports provided are the same as the Special Access DSR Ports described in Section 23 of this tariff.

In addition to an installation charge, many of the WITS 2000 services also may be subject to three other one-time nonrecurring charges (NRCs). They are:

Cancellation Charge: this charge may be incurred when a service or optional feature is cancelled within one week of the scheduled due date.

Disconnect Charge: this charge may be incurred when a service or an option feature is completely removed/disconnected.

Hard Change Charge: a charge that may be incurred when a change in service requires the dispatch of a technician to the customer's site to make changes in facilities or equipment; e.g., a service is moved from one location to another.
