Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 157 without its becoming effective.

On May 31, 2007, NBTC issued Transmittal No. 157 which proposed clarifications to existing rules and regulations as they relate to the Optical-to-Electrical Add/Drop Capability feature for Dedicated SONET Ring Services. NBTC sought to (1) add a change in regulation to the OC-192 Add/Drop Capability Section; (2) add clarifying language to the Optical-to-Electrical DS-1 Add/Drop Capability Section; (3) make text changes and remove erroneous information from the OC-192 Optical-to-Electrical Add/Drop Capability Section; (4) add a nonrecurring charge for Subsequent Installation per Add/Drop Capability for OC-192 Rings; and (5) reduce the 60-month rate for the OC-192 DS-3 Transmux Re-Map port feature. Transmittal No. 157 is scheduled to become effective on June 15, 2007.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw material filed under Transmittal No. 157 without its becoming effective and to restore currently effective material. NBTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal No. 157 in order to review issues identified in the proposed modifications.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that is not yet in effect.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff page are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
