USERS GUIDE

General

This tariff references the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 for its terms and conditions. This tariff contains rates applicable to Interstate Access Services provided within the State of Iowa by the Royal Telephone Company with the exception of Carrier Common Line and End User Access Service rates. Carrier Common Line and End User Access Service rates are as set forth in National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, at 17.1.1 and 17.1.2.

Royal Telephone Company has filed this tariff in accordance with the F.C.C. Part 61 rules in 47 C.F.R. Section 61.39 as promulgated by the Report and Order in CC Docket No. 86-467, adopted May 14, 1987 and released June 29, 1987. Therefore, this tariff cross references the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 for terms and conditions.

## ACCESS SERVICE

1. Application of Tariff

- 1.1 This tariff contains rates and charges applicable to the provision of Switched Access and Special Access Services, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service, provided by the Royal Telephone Company, hereinafter referred to as the Telephone Company, to customers. This tariff also contains Access Ordering charges that are applicable when these services are ordered or modified by the customer.
- 1.2 The provision of such service by the Telephone Company as set forth in this tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the Customer for the furnishing of any service.
- 1.3 Royal Telephone Company, in accordance with the provisions of Part 61.39(a) of the F.C.C.'s Rules and Regulations, has elected to file its own tariff and reference the regulations, terms and conditions of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (NECA) Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Access Service, for the General Regulations, End User Common Line, Carrier Common Line, Switched Access Services, Special Access Services, and other miscellaneous services contained therein. Regulations, terms and conditions applicable to these services are therefore specifically cross referenced and included in the following sections of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. (NECA) Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.

The regulations, terms and conditions for Digital Subscriber Line Access Service are the same as those set forth in Section 8 of the National Exchange Carrier Association, (NECA) Inc. Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.



9. Directory Assistance Service

The regulations, terms and conditions for Directory Assistance Service are not applicable as set forth in Section 9 of the National Exchange Carrier Association, (NECA) Inc. Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. This service is not offered by Gridley Telephone Company.
