Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 18, 2007, Michael Fingerhut and I, of Sprint Nextel Corp., Richard Metzger of Lawler, Metzger, Milkman and Keeney, LLC, and Marc Goldman of Jenner and Block (via telephone), both Sprint Nextel's outside counsel, met with Deena Shetler, Al Lewis, Jay Atkinson, Doug Slotten, Don Stockdale and Lynne Engledow of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss possible issues to be investigated in WCB/Pricing No. 07-10. Sprint Nextel recommended that the Commission investigate (1) marketing arrangements the ILECs whose tariffs are the subject of this proceeding, have or may plan to enter into for the purposes of stimulating traffic; and (2) numbering resource utilization by these ILECs. Sprint Nextel also provided Commission staff with a summary of court activity in the various traffic pumping cases brought by Sprint Nextel and other long distance carriers in the US District Court for the Southern District of Iowa.
