On August 22, 2007, Eric Einhorn, Cesar Caballero, Bill Kreutz, and Tim Logan of Windstream Communications, Inc (“Windstream”), together with Jeff Glover, John Jones, Nolan Moullé, and Ted Hankins of CenturyTel, Inc. (“CenturyTel”), and myself, on behalf of CenturyTel, participated in a conference call with Don Stockdale, Al Lewis, Deena Shetler, Pam Arluk, Doug Slotten, and Jay Atkinson of the Wireline Competition Bureau. During the call, CenturyTel and Windstream discussed their continuing concerns with the inclusion of their annual access tariff filings in the above-referenced tariff investigation, and reiterated their opposition to “traffic pumping” activities. The discussion was consistent with filings that CenturyTel and Windstream have previously made in this proceeding.
