With this filing, BellSouth is revising Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to make certain rate changes for BellSouth Wavelength SWA Dedicated Ring Service Components to mirror the equivalent special access rates for Wavelength Dedicated Ring Service in Section 29 of F.C.C. Tariff No. 1. The rate changes will result in a rate reduction for all rate elements except one rate element, which will increase.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
