- Provide a revised TRP with updated exogenous cost which reflects the revised Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) factor of .00720, released by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) on June 29, 2007.
- Revise the Universal Service Fund (USF) factor, DA 07-3928, released September 13, 2007 to calculate the 4th Quarter 2007 USF obligations.
- Update line counts used in the calculation of the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) recovery charges billed to residential and business customers.
