regulation of its broadband services.<sup>2</sup> The FCC's Order required that ACS-ANC exit the NECA Common line pooling process and tariffs for the Anchorage study area as one of the conditions for granting forbearance relief.

As a result, this filing introduces rates, terms and conditions for End User Common Line Access Service, Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC), ISDN Line Ports and the DS1 line Port. There are no changes in the rates from those currently applicable to ACS-ANC as a member of the NECA pooling process. Additionally, pursuant to the pricing flexibility relief granted in the FCC's Order, cost support is not required for this filing.

FCC Tariff No. 1 tariff pages, as appropriately revised, are attached to this submittal.
