Elsie Communications respectfully requests special permission to waive Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules in order that it may cancel its F.C.C. No. 1 Interstate Access Tariff on not less than three-days' notice, to become effective October 1, 2007, instead of on 15-days' notice.

Elsie Communications, Inc. would like to cancel its tariff to coincide with returning to the National Exchange Carrier Association's F.C.C. Tariff No. 5 which is proposed to become effective October 1, 2007.
