The accompany tariff material issued by Royal Telephone Company ("Royal") and bearing F.C.C. No. 1 Access Service, is being filed in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

This filing is being made under the authority of **Special Permission No. 07-026** granted by the Federal Communications Commission on September 24, 2007. With this filing Royal is canceling the Royal Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 in its entirety on not less than three days' notice. NECA is allowing Royal to re-enter the NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 as an issuing carrier outside of the annual election period. The effective date of this filing is scheduled to be in concurrence with the filing to be made by NECA reestablishing Royal as an issuing carrier of the NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Access Service.
