Section 1 -- APPLICATION

This tariff applies to interstate Access Service supplied to Customers for origination and termination of traffic within the operating territory of Cablevision Lightpath, Inc., (C) Cablevision Lightpath – CT, Inc., and Cablevision Lightpath – NJ, Inc.

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Section 2 -- DEFINITIONS

Certain terms used generally throughout this tariff are described below.

Advance Payment

Part or all of a payment required before the start of Service.

(C)

Access Services or Services

The Company's interstate communications services offered pursuant to this tariff, including both Switched Access Services and Dedicated Access Services.

Company

Company, the issuer of this tariff, and its concurring subsidiaries and affiliates.

Customer

The person, firm or corporation that orders Service and is responsible for the payment of charges and compliance with the Company's regulations.

(C)

Dedicated Access Service

A dedicated path between a Customer's premises and another point of presence for the purpose of originating or terminating communications.

LATA

A Local Access and Transport Area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-0192; or any other geographic area designated as a LATA in the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. Recurring Charges

The monthly charges to the Customer for Access Services, facilities and equipment which continue for the agreed upon duration of the Service.

Section 2 -- DEFINITIONS (cont'd)**Service Commencement Date**

The first date on which the Company notifies the Customer that the requested Service or facility is available for use, unless extended by the Customer's refusal to accept Service which does not conform to standards set forth in the Service Order or this tariff, in which case the Service Commencement Date is the date of the Customer's acceptance. The Company and the Customer may mutually agree on a substitute Service Commencement Date. If the Company does not have an executed Service Order from a customer, the Service Commencement Date will be the first date on which the Service or facility was used by a customer. (C)

Service Order

The written request for Access Services executed by the Customer and the Company in the format devised by the Company. The signing of a Service Order by the Customer and acceptance by the Company initiates the respective obligations of the parties as set forth therein and pursuant to this tariff, but the duration of the Service is calculated from the Service Commencement Date. Should a customer use the Company's Access Service without an executed Service Order, the Company will then request the customer to submit a Service Order. (C)

Shared

A facility or equipment system or subsystem that can be used simultaneously by several Customers.

Switched Access Service

Access to the switched network of an exchange carrier for the purpose of originating or terminating communications. (N)

User

A Customer or any other person authorized by the Customer to use Services provided under this tariff. (C)

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Section 3 -- REGULATIONS

3.1 Undertaking of the Company

3.1.1 Scope

The Company undertakes to furnish Access Services in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this tariff. (C)

3.1.2 Shortage of Facilities

All Service is subject to the availability of suitable facilities. The Company reserves the right to limit the length of communications or to discontinue furnishing Services when necessary because of the lack of transmission medium capacity or because of any causes beyond its control. (C)

3.1.3 Terms and Conditions

- (A) Service is provided on the basis of a minimum period of at least one month, 24-hours per day. For the purpose of computing charges in this tariff, a month is considered to have 30 days.
- (B) Customers may be required to enter into written service orders which shall contain or reference a specific description of the Service ordered, the rates to be charged, the duration of the Services, and the terms and conditions in this tariff. Customer will also be required to execute any other documents as may be reasonably requested by the Company. (C)

3.1 Undertaking of the Company (cont'd)

3.1.3 Terms and Conditions (cont'd)

- (C) In any action between the parties to enforce any provision of this tariff the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover its legal fees and court costs from the non-prevailing party in addition to other relief a court may award.

- (D) This tariff shall be interpreted and governed by the laws of the United States without regard for its choice of laws provision.

3.1 Undertaking of the Company (cont'd)

3.1.4 Liability of the Company

- (A) Except as stated in this Section 3.1.4, the Company shall have no liability for damages of any kind arising out of or related to events, acts, rights or privileges contemplated in this tariff. This tariff does not limit the liability of the Company for willful misconduct.

- (B) The liability of the Company for damages resulting in whole or in part from or arising in connection with the furnishing of Service under this tariff, (C)
Including but not limited to mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or other defects or misrepresentations shall not exceed an amount equal to five times the initial period charge provided for under this tariff for any call for the period during which the call was affected. No other liability in any event shall attach to the Company.

3.1.4 Liability of the Company (cont'd)

- (C) The Company shall not be liable for any failure of performance hereunder due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of God, fires, flood or other catastrophes; failure of utility services; any law, order, regulation, directive, action or request of the United States Government, or any other government, including state and local governments having jurisdiction over the Company, or of any department, agency, commission, bureau, corporation or other instrumentality of any one or more of said governments, or of any civil or military authority; national emergencies, insurrections, riots, wars or other labor difficulties.
- (D) The Company shall not be liable for any act or omission of any other entity furnishing to the Customer facilities, equipment, or services used with the Company's Access Services. Nor shall the Company be liable for any damages or losses due to unauthorized use of the Service or the failure or negligence of the Customer or due to the failure of the Customer-provided equipment, facilities or services. (C)

3.1.5 Claims

The Company shall be indemnified and saved harmless by the Customer from and against all loss, liability, damage and expense, including reasonable counsel fees, due to claims of libel, slander, or infringement of copyright in connection with the material transmitted over the Company's facilities; and any other claim resulting from any act or omission of the Customer or patron(s) of the Customer relating to the use of the Company's Services or facilities. (C)

3.1 Undertaking of the Company (cont'd)

3.1.6 Provision of Equipment and Facilities

- (A) Except as otherwise indicated, customer-provided station equipment at the Customer's premises for use in conjunction with this Service shall be so constructed, maintained and operated as to work satisfactorily with the facilities of the Company. (C)
- (B) The company shall not be responsible for the installation, operation or maintenance of any Customer-provided communications equipment. Where such equipment is connected to Service furnished pursuant to this tariff, the responsibility of the Company shall be limited to the furnishing of Access Services under this tariff and to the maintenance and operation of such Services in the proper manner. Subject to this responsibility, the Company shall not be responsible for: (C)
- (1) the through transmission of signals generated by Customer-provided equipment or for the quality of, or defects in, such transmission; or
 - (2) the reception of signals by Customer-provided equipment; or
 - (3) network control signaling where such signaling is performed by Customer-provided network control signaling equipment.

3.1.7 Ownership of Facilities

Title to all facilities provided in accordance with this tariff remains in the Company, its agents, contractors or suppliers.

Section 3 -- REGULATIONS (cont'd)

3.2 Prohibited Uses

- (A) The Services the Company offers shall not be used for any unlawful purpose or for any use for which the Customer has not obtained all required governmental approvals, authorization, licenses, consents and permits. (C)
- (B) The Company may require applicants for Service who intend to use the Company's offering for resale and/or for shared use to file a letter with the Company confirming that their use of the Company's offerings complies with relevant laws and regulations, policies, orders and decisions. (C)
- (C) The Company may require a Customer to immediately shut down its transmission if such transmission is causing interference to others.
- (D) A customer, joint user, or authorized user may not assign, or transfer in any manner, the Service or any rights associated with the Service without the written consent of the Company. The Company will permit a Customer to transfer its existing Service to another entity if the existing Customer has paid all charges owed to the Company for Access Services. Such a transfer will be treated as a disconnection of existing Service and installation of new Service, and non-recurring installation charges as stated in this tariff will apply. (C)

3.3 Obligations of the Customer

3.3.1 Customer Premises Provisions

- (A) The Customer shall provide the personnel, power and space required to operate all facilities and associated equipment installed on the premises of the Customer.
- (B) The Customer shall be responsible for providing Company personnel access to premises of the Customer at any reasonable hour for the purpose of testing the facilities or equipment of the Company.

3.3.2 Liability of the Customer

The Customer will be liable for damages to the facilities of the Company caused by negligence or willful acts of its offices, employees, agents or contractors of the Customer where such negligence or willful acts is not the direct result of the Company's negligence.

Section 3 -- REGULATIONS (cont'd)**3.3 Obligations of the Customer****3.3.3 Jurisdictional Report Requirements for Switched Access Services** (C)

- (A) For Feature Group D Switched Access Service(s), the Company, where jurisdiction can be determined from the call detail, will determine the projected interstate percentage as follows. For originating access minutes, the projected interstate percentage will be developed on a monthly basis by end office when the Feature Group D, Switched Access Service access minutes are measured by dividing the measured interstate originating access minutes (the access minutes where the calling number is in one state and the called number is in another state) by the total originating access minutes when the call detail is adequate to determine the appropriate jurisdiction. For terminating access minutes, the data used by the Company to develop the projected interstate percentage for originating access minutes will be used to develop projected interstate percentage for such terminating access minutes. When a customer orders Feature Group D Switched Access Service, the customer shall supply projected interstate percentage of use for each end office involved to be used in the event that originating call details are insufficient to determine the jurisdiction for the call. This percentage shall be used by the Company as the projected interstate percentage for such call detail. For purposes of developing the projected interstate percentage, the customer shall utilize the same considerations as those set forth in Section 3.3.3.B preceding. The Company will designate the number obtained by subtracting the projected interstate percentage for originating and terminating access minutes from 100 (100 - projected interstate percentage = intrastate percentage) as the projected intrastate percentage of use.

3.3 Obligations of the Customer (cont'd)

3.3.3 Jurisdictional Report Requirements for Switched Access Services (cont'd) (C)

- (B) For purposes of developing the projected interstate percentage, the customer shall consider every call that enters the customer's network at a point within the same state as the state where the called station is located to be intrastate and every call that enters the customer's network at a point in a state different from the state in which the called station is located to be interstate.
- (C) These whole number percentages will be used by the Company to apportion the use, rates, and/or non-recurring charges between interstate and intrastate until a revised report is received.
- (D) The projected interstate percentage of use will be used to determine the charges as follows:

The number of access minutes for a group will be multiplied by the projected interstate percentage of use to determine the interstate access minutes. (i.e., number of access minutes x projected interstate percentage of use = interstate access minutes). The number of interstate access minutes so determined will be subtracted from the total number of access minutes (i.e., number of access minutes - interstate access minutes = intrastate access minutes). The interstate access minutes for the group will be billed as set forth in Section 5 following.

3.3 Obligations of the Customer (cont'd)

3.3.3 Jurisdictional Report Requirements for Switched Access Services (cont'd) (C)

- (E) Effective on the first of January, April, July and October of each year, the customer may update the jurisdictional reports that require a projected interstate or RTU interstate percentage. The customer shall forward to the Company, to be received no later than 20 calendar days after the first of each such month, a revised report showing the interstate percentage of use for the past three months ending the last day of December, March, June and September, respectively, for each Service arranged for interstate and intrastate use. Except as set forth in (3) preceding where jurisdiction (C) be determined from the recorded message detail, the revised report will serve as the basis for the next three months billing and will be effective on the bill date in the following month (i.e., February, May, August, and November) for that Service. No prorating or back billing will be done based(C) on the report. If the customer does not supply the report, the Company will assume the percentage to be the same as that provided in the last quarterly report.

3.3 Obligations of the Customer (cont'd)

3.3.3 Jurisdictional Report Requirements for Switched Access Services (cont'd) (C)

- (F) The customer reported projected interstate percentage of use as set forth in Section 3.3.3.A preceding will be used for the apportionment of rates or non-recurring charges associated with Feature Group D Switched Access Service until the end of the quarter during which the Service was activated. Thereafter, a projected interstate percentage or such apportionment will be developed quarterly by the Company based on the data used to develop the projected interstate percentage of use as set forth in Section 3.3.3.A preceding. Where call detail is insufficient to make such a determination, the customer will be requested to project an interstate percentage of use to be used by the Company for apportionment. (C)
- (G) The customer shall keep sufficient detail from which the percentage of interstate use can be ascertained and upon request of the Company make the records available for inspection. Such a request will be initiated by the Company no more than once per year. The customer shall supply the data within 30 calendar days of the Company request.

3.4 Customer Equipment and Channels

3.4.1 Interconnection of Facilities

- (A) In order to protect the Company's facilities and personnel and the services furnished to other customers by the Company from potentially harmful effects, the signals applied to the Company's Service shall be such as not to cause damage to the facilities of the Company. Any special interface equipment necessary to achieve the compatibility between facilities of the Company and the channels or facilities of others shall be provided at the Customer's expense. (C)

3.4 Customer Equipment and Channels (cont'd)

3.4.2 Inspections

- (A) The Company may, upon notification to the Customer, at a reasonable time, make such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine that the requirements regarding the equipment and interconnections are being complied with the installation, operation and maintenance of Customer-provided equipment and in the wiring of the connection of Customer channels to Company-owned facilities.
- (B) If the protective requirements in connections with Customer-provided equipment are not being complied with, the Company may take such action as necessary to protect its facilities and personnel and will promptly notify the Customer by registered mail in writing of the need for protective action. In the event that the Customer fails to advise the Company within 10 days after such notice is received or within the time specified in the notice that corrective action has been taken, the Company may take whatever additional action is deemed necessary, including the suspension of Service, to protect its facilities and personnel from harm. The Company will upon request 24 hours in advance provide Customer with a statement of technical parameters that the Customer's equipment must meet.

3.5 Customer Deposits and Advance Payments

Customers without an established credit rating or with a negative credit rating shall be required to deposit with Company an amount equivalent of up to two months of actual or estimated monthly charges.

All deposits shall bear simple interest at the same percentage rate as that set forth in Section 3.6.1.B. Interest shall not accrue on any deposit after the date on which a reasonable effort has been made to return it to the customer. At the Company's option, such deposit may be refunded or credited to the customer at, or any time prior to, termination of Service.

3.6 Payment Arrangements

3.6.1 Payment for Service

- (A) The Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for facilities and Services furnished by the Company. Applicable federal, state, and local sales, use, and excise taxes, and federal, state, and local fees and surcharges shall be added to the charges contained herein. It shall be the responsibility of the Customer to pay these taxes that may subsequently become applicable retroactively. (C)

- (B) Bills are due and payable within 30 days. If the Customer's net bill is not paid (payment received by the Company) within sixty (60) days after rendition of the invoice it shall become a delinquent bill and interest at the lesser of (1) the rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month or (2) the highest rate allowed by law per month shall accrue upon any unpaid amount due hereunder and the Company substantially prevails in such proceedings then the defendant Customer shall pay the reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of the Company in prosecuting such proceedings and appeals there from.

3.6 Payment Arrangements (cont'd)

3.6.1 Payment for Service (cont'd)

- (C) The Customer will be assessed a charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each check submitted by the Customer to the Company which a financial institution refuses to honor for insufficient funds or a non-existent account.
- (D) Customers have up to 90 days (commencing 5 days after remittance of the bill) to initiate a dispute over charges or to receive credits.
- (E) If Service is disconnected by the Company in accordance with section 3.6.2 following and later restored, restoration of Service will be subject to all applicable installation charges. (C)

3.6.2 Discontinuance of Service for Cause

The Company may discontinue Service or cancel an application for service without incurring any liability for any of the following reasons: (C)

- (A) Upon non-payment of any sum owing to the Company for more than 30 days beyond the date of rendition of the bill service or upon violation of any of the terms or conditions governing the furnishing of Service under this tariff, the Company may, on 30 days advance notice in writing to the Customer, without incurring any liability, discontinue the furnish of Service under this tariff. (C)

3.6.2 Discontinuance of Service for Cause (cont'd)

- (B) Without notice, in the event of a violation of any regulation governing the Service under this tariff; (C)
- (C) Without notice, in the event of a violation of any law, rule, or regulation of any government authority having jurisdiction over the Service; or (C)
- (D) The Company is prohibited from furnishing Services by order of a court or other government authority having jurisdiction. (C)
- (E) In the event of fraudulent use of the Company's network, the Company will discontinue Service without notice and/or seek legal recourse to recover all costs involved in enforcement of this provision. (C)

3.6.3 Notice to Company for Cancellation of Service

Customers desiring to terminate Service shall provide Company thirty (30) days written notice of desire to terminate Service. (C)

3.7 Application of Rates

The regulations set forth in this section govern the application of rates for Services contained in other sections of this tariff. (C)

3.7.1 Switched Access Charges Based on Duration of Use (C)

Customer traffic to end offices will be measured by the Company at end office switches. Originating and terminating calls will be measured by the Company to determine the basis for computing chargeable access minutes.

For originating calls over Feature Group D, usage measurement begins when the originating Feature Group D switch receives the first wink supervisory signal forwarded from the customer's point of termination.

The measurement of originating call usage ends when the originating Feature Group D switch receives disconnect supervision from either the originating end user's end office, indicating the originating end user has disconnected, or the customer's point of termination, whichever is recognized first by the switch.

For terminating calls over Feature Group D, the measurement of access minutes begins when the terminating Feature Group D switch receives answer supervision from the terminating end user's end office, indicating the terminating end user has answered.

3.7 Application of Rates (cont'd)

3.7.1 Switched Access Charges Based on Duration of Use (cont'd)

(C)

The measurement of terminating call usage over Feature Group D ends when the terminating Feature Group D switch receives disconnect supervision from either the terminating end user's end office, indicating the terminating end user has disconnected, or the customer's point of termination, whichever is recognized first by the switch.

Calls are measured in seconds of use and rounded up to whole minutes of use for a monthly billing cycle.

3.7.2 Customer Specific Contracts for Access Services

(C)

The Company may provide any of the Access Services offered under this tariff, or combinations of Services, to Customers on a contractual basis (Individual Case Basis or ICB). The terms and conditions of each contract offering are subject to the agreement of both the Customer and the Company. Such contract offerings will be made available to similarly situated Customers in substantially similar circumstances. Rates in other sections of this tariff do not apply to Customers who agree to contract arrangements, with respect to Services within the scope of the contract. The rates provided under such contract offerings are listed in Appendix A.

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Section 4 -- SERVICE DESCRIPTION

4.1 Switched Access Services

The Company provides Feature Group D originating and terminating equal access. Local transport arrangements for dedicated service are to be arranged by the customer with the provider of choice. Interconnection arrangements will be established on a contract specific basis.

4.1.1 New York

Tandem Switched Transport is provided in conjunction with Verizon New York Inc. or another Tandem Switched Transport provider selected by the Company. (C)
Charges for Tandem Switched Transport are computed utilizing V&H coordinates that are commonly used in standard industry practice. (C)

4.1.2 Connecticut (Verizon Territory)

Tandem Switched Transport is provided in conjunction with Verizon New York Inc. or another Tandem Switched Transport provider selected by the Company. (C)
Charges for Tandem Switched Transport are computed utilizing V&H coordinates that are commonly used in standard industry practice. (C)

4.1.3 Connecticut (SNET Territory)

Tandem Switched Transport is provided in conjunction with the Southern New England Telephone Company d/b/a SBC Connecticut or another Tandem Switched Transport provider selected by the Company. Charges for Tandem Switched Transport are computed utilizing V&H coordinates that are commonly used in standard industry practice. (C)
